

HIV Outcomes Europe Achievements - 2021

July

- In excess of 150 people attended the HIV Outcomes' satellite symposium at IAS 2021 one of the most influential forums on HIV. The symposium was entitled **Supporting health-related quality** of life for people living with HIV. Lessons and learnings from the COVID-19 Pandemic
- Over 70 organisations have endorsed the Consensus Statement on the role of health systems in advancing the long-term well-being of people living with HIV. Led by HIV Outcomes Co-Chair Jeffrey Lazarus, the Consensus Statement is available for endorsement on the HIV Outcomes website.
- HIV Outcomes amendments were taken onboard in the European Parliament's negotiating position on the proposal to extend the mandate of the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control – the EU's main viral diseases agency – to ensure that the new ECDC capacities support the fight against current and not just future viral threats.
- HIV Outcomes made a submission to the World Health Organization (WHO) public consultation on the revised Global Health Sector Strategies for HIV, Viral Hepatitis and STIs for 2022-2030
- Our <u>Twitter</u> account reached **1,000 followers**, **250,000 impressions**, **14,000 profile visits** and **500** likes since last July.

June

- Over 100 people have downloaded our new Advocacy Tool Box factsheets on the health-related quality of life of people living with HIV.
- Several HIV Outcomes' amendments calling for the adoption of integrated care models for long-term conditions like HIV were tabled in the EU Pharmaceutical Strategy draft report, creating a regulatory framework that meets patients' unmet medical needs.
- WHO formally invited HIV Outcomes to participate in the public consultation on the revised Global Health Sector Strategies for HIV, Viral Hepatitis and STIs for 2022-2030.
- Thanks to our advocacy efforts, the 2021 Work Plan of EU4Health, the largest funding programme for health projects, included funding for HIV-related projects and improving EU-level viral diseases monitoring.
- HIV Outcomes was featured in **Politico Europe's article** 'HIV in Europe: innovating to end the *epidemic'* sponsored by one of our co-sponsors.
- HIV Outcomes Co-Chair Jeffrey Lazarus participated in Politico's Live Event: "Telescope: The New AIDS Epidemic – 95-95-95: beyond business as usual".
- Thanks to our advocacy efforts, COVID-19's impact on access to HIV testing and on the need to safeguard patients' rights to access sexual and reproductive health services is recognised in the European Parliament Sexual and Reproductive Health Report.

- Following our meeting with a high-level European Commission Health official, HIV Outcomes called for expanding the Commission's well-respected Steering Group on Non-Communicable Diseases to Communicable Diseases.
- Thanks to our **partnership with UNAIDS**, the **need to improve quality of life** and long-term well-being amongst **people living with HIV**, was mentioned in a European Parliament resolution on **ending AIDS** as a public health threat by 2030.
- Thanks to our partnership with UNAIDS, the importance of adopting differentiated care models that improve quality of life amongst people living with HIV was captured in the United Nations Secretary-General Report during the 2021 UN General Assembly.
- HIV Outcomes was **featured in Politico Europe's** article <u>'Partners in a pandemic response'</u> sponsored by one of our co-sponsors.

April

Two new best practice case studies from the <u>UK</u> and <u>Europe</u> were added to our **Compendium of Best Practices and have been downloaded over 50 times.**

March

- Thanks to our partnership with UNAIDS, various commitments to ensuring better quality of life for people living with HIV through integrated systems of care are referenced in the new UNAIDS Global AIDS Strategy (2021-2026).
- Politico's **Telescope** article on <u>'The New AIDS Epidemic: New targets in the fight against HIV'</u> featuring our Co-Chairs Jane and Jeff was published.

February

- A working definition for health-related quality of life for people living with HIV was agreed at a Focus Group Discussion, co-hosted with UNAIDS and attended by over 40 HIV stakeholders.
- HIV Outcomes and UNITE Network partnered to submit a joint response to the public consultation on the proposal to extend the mandate of European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control.
